




Montgomery County high school grads who earn bachelor's degrees make **48% more** than those who don't

More than **8 in 10** 2020 graduates returned to college a second year (83%)




Who starts college?

Persists a second year, Oakwood 2019-20 high school graduating class




FAFSA Completion
